ITINERARY HIGHLIGHTS

Below are all the things you should visit on this full day out in Lauterbrunnen.



Schilthorn & Piz Gloria

Time Required: 1-2 hours

Attractions: Piz Gloria revolving restaurant,

Skyline View platform with Bond Walk of Fame,

Spy World museum, Cinema

The views and rotating restaurant are to die for. Head right to the top of the Schilthorn immediately to beat the crowds. Soak up the views and visit the 007 museum, cinema, and viewpoints. You can also book a brunch at the revolving restaurant, which is a one-of-a-kind experience as it gives you 360-degree views while you eat.



Birg - Thrill Walk & Skyline Walk

Time Required: 1 hour

Attractions: Skyline Walk & Thrill Walk

Hike to Birg-Grauseeli

Birg is one stop on the gondola below the Schilthorn and another great spot for some adventure. For height-sensitive people, you can just go to the Skyline viewpoint for stunning views of the big three (Eiger, Mönch, Jungfrau). For the rest, head down for a heart-stopping Thrill Walk on the cliff below. More time is required if you do the hike or stop for a break here.



Mürren

Time Required: 1-2 hours

Attractions: The village, restaurants, Allmendhubel flower

trail and playground (via funicular).

This enchanting Swiss Alpine town is one of a kind. Car-free, with historic wooden houses and views you won't believe. A great spot to pause for lunch or just grab a drink and enjoy the views. You could actually spend a whole day here with all the hikes and a visit to Allmendhubel (family-friendly). At the very least, explore the upper and lower roads, find the viewpoints and have a break.
